Background

Hopewell Hospice is the only dedicated palliative care facility servicing the Gold Coast and surrounding regions. The genuinely compassionate team at Hopewell understand how difficult it is to care for a dying family member. There's so much uncertainty and it is a very physical and emotionally draining task. Hopewell's services aim to alleviate some of this strain, allowing carers to do what's most important – spend quality time with their loved ones.

Hopewell provides

Hospice and palliative care

8 bed hospice with 24-hour on-site nursing, ancillary services and accommodation for anyone with life-limiting illnesses at the end stage of life. Hopewell also offers a range of support services for families and loved ones.

Grief and loss support

Counselling is offered to all our guests, as well as their family and loved ones. Our counsellors are well trained in all grief and loss issues. For people experiencing difficulties surrounding the relationship with the person who has died, additional support is available through The Hopewell Centre.

Hopewell recognises that grief is not a linear journey and will continue to support families after the death of their loved one. Staff value the special relationships they make with guests and families and remain connected for some time.

Hopewell outreach

Receiving palliative care at home means that our patients are close to their belongings and memories, all while receiving the best care and support. Our program provides adults with holistic palliative care through the coordination of nursing, pastoral care and social support.
