YHARS - Youth Housing & Reintegration Service AFTER CARE

YHARS BROKERAGE is financial support designed to achieve your case plan GOALS.

- Do you have a Case Plan?
- Are there Goals on that plan that are really hard to get to because they cost money?

SUPPORT PLANNING = Possible YHARS Application

To be eligible for YHARS AfterCare, you must be linked with an organisation that is helping you set and take steps toward achieving your personal goals. You must be actively involved in setting and achieving your goal plan (this is sometimes referred to a case plan) with this organisation. Organisations refer to this process as 'case management'.

Case management is one of the eligibility requirements for accessing YHARS AfterCare.

YHARS is in place to help young people who are struggling to find and stabilize their accommodation.

We are funded under the **National Housing and Homelessness Agreement (NHHA)**.
This means this support is designed specially to support those at a higher risk of being homeless.

This means that you might be at risk of:

Primary homelessness: when people don't have conventional accommodation. For example, sleeping rough or in improvised dwellings like sleeping in their car.

Secondary homelessness: when people are forced to move from one temporary shelter to another, like 'couch surfing' which is when someone 'crashes' at the home of a friend or relative.

Tertiary homelessness: when people live in accommodation that falls below minimum standards.

ARE YOU

- 17 - 21 years?
- homeless or at risk of homelessness? and
- leaving or have recently left care?

DO YOU

- Have a case plan and a support worker?
- Have life goals that have financial barriers?

IF you can tick ALL 5 of the above then you can apply.
